Presentation and goals

This workshop responds to this need for trained professionals to

- Learn from active experiencing of mediation based on Action Methods
- Develop their understanding, their methodology and their skills

Method

A semi-fictive role-play of a "team in conflict with high level of conflictual tensions" will be set on the first day. It will last till the third day included.

The "team in conflict" will go as far as it can during this process, little step by little step, in order to diminish the level of conflictual tensions and transform their conflicts.

Times of mediation will alternate with times of stepping back and reflecting collectively.

The diverse learning will stem -for each and everyone - from this alliance of perspectives. Diverse syntheses of the learning will be created, including a list of "Do's and Don't".
